

**BRYAN BOWERS BAND—WOODLAND DREAM**—Patuxent Music CD-329. Fans of autoharp and mandolin should enjoy this new release from Bryan Bowers, his first in a number of years. Besides autoharp, Bowers also plays

mandocello, and guitar. He's joined by Danny Knicely (mandocello, mandolin, and guitar) and Geoff Goodhue (mandolin and guitar). The project is a collection of some familiar and some not-so-familiar tunes, including "Sitting On Top Of The World," "Cluck Ol' Hen," and "Gold Watch And Chain." The a cappella harmonies are excellent on "Too Old To Die Young," "Dem Deer," "Parting Glass," and the title-cut "Woodland Dream." The trio reinvents The Dillards' "Hey Boys" and their version of Ola Belle Reed's "High On A Mountain" is chilling. They even cover The Shirelles' "Will You Love Me Tomorrow."
