instrumentals. New Fall Reel, the opening track, and Burning Well have a progressive feel; Cedarwood is slow and very enjoyable. Tom Mindte is the lead vocalist and does an excellent job on Why Did You Wander and I've Just Seen The Rock Of Ages. Nate has enlisted some great talent to come up with a recording that is first class and a must-have project.
