

DANIEL GREESON—DONE GONE—Patuxent Music CD-313. This is a fiddle project, pure and simple. Daniel Greeson has picked a fine selection of tunes, some new, some not so new, and a few familiars like “Red Apple Rag” and “Ragtime Annie.” Greeson is helped in the studio by Taylor Baker (mandolin), Brennen Ernst (banjo), Danny Knicely (guitar), and Marshall Wilborn (bass), with guests Corrina Rose Logston (fiddle), Casey Driscoll (fiddle), and Tom Mindte (vocal). The CD opens with “Georgia Slim’s Done Gone,” allowing Greeson to show his mettle on the fiddle. There are a couple of nice waltzes—“Festival Waltz” and “Joyce Cauthen Waltz.” Producer Tom Mindte sings Benny Martin’s classic “Me And My Fiddle,” and Logston and Driscoll join Greeson on Bill Monroe’s triple fiddle classic “Tall Timber.” Other selections include “Draggin’ The Bow,” “Ducks On The Mill Pond,” “Tune For Andy,” and “Fiddler’s Pastime.” Fiddle players take note, this young man is good.
