Isabella Gorman (fiddle), and Lauren Wasmund (vocals) tackle some new compositions like "Victor Vindaloo," "Gypsy Queen," "Do You Believe In Ghosts?," "Mississippi Pearl," and "It Takes One To Know One." The quartet also does some fine picking on the traditional tunes "Breaking Up Christmas," "Richmond," "Durang's Hornpipe," and "Julianne Johnson."
